This year's meeting will be held in person on **Tuesday 16th June 2026 at 7:00pm at the Laggan Wolftrax Centre**. The formal part of the AGM will be followed by a discussion of future plans of the Trust in relation to the surrounding forest estate owned by Forestry and Land Scotland. This will be an open forum for members and residents of Laggan.

Election of Trustee Directors:

The meeting will formally seek the adoption of the Trustee's Report, the Annual Financial Statements – both to the end of September 2025, and the Election of Trustee Directors.

The minimum number of board members that the Trust requires is five (5). At the date of the AGM there are 3 member directors and 2 co-opted directors available for re-election, all of whom have indicated their willingness to continue as Trustee Directors. They are:

3 Member directors, Donald Cowan, David Narro and Patrick Gallagher are able to continue in office.
2 Co-opted Directors, Megan Griffiths and Colin Morgan both retire at the AGM – and are eligible for re-appointment. Both have indicated their willingness to continue if approved.

The Laggan Forest Trust would welcome the nomination of any new director/trustees to help guide our future work in Forestry and Recreational Access. Such a nomination can be for a member resident in the community or a co-optee with relevant experience not necessarily a member nor living in the area.
